RESTART – REINFORCE ENTREPRENEURIAL AND DIGITAL SKILLS OF STUDENTS AND TEACHERS TO ENHANCE THE MODERNIZATION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN MOLDOVA

The Erasmus + project "ReSTART - *Reinforce entrepreneurial and digital skills of students and teachers to enhance the modernization of higher education in Moldova*" is co-funded by the European Commission through the Erasmus + KA2 - Capacity Building Program in the Field of Higher Education, starting October 15, 2017 on a 3 years term. The project in question provides the modernization of the master's program *Business Administration in the Agri-Food Sector*.

Due to the ReSTART project, at the UASM 6 university courses have been upgraded for students from the second cycle, from the specialization of Business Administration in the Agri-Food Sector. To now, 5 information sessions, 4 professional career guidance sessions for master students, 4 follow-up sessions, 1 Event multiplier session and 2 trainers training sessions were organized in Bucharest and Košice.
