Entrepreneurship and Business Administration is the master degree program which curriculum has been modernized within the ReSTART project.


The aim of the project was to integrate and improve the digital learning and entrepreneurship needs of students, teachers and local businesses based on internationalization, strategic partnerships and innovative cooperation, within the Cahul State University "B.P. Hasdeu".

The general objective of the ReSTART project was to extend the benefits and increase the impact of the modernized entrepreneurial curriculum on second cycle master students and scientific and teaching staff, by capitalizing on advanced experience in the field, in higher education institutions within the consortium. The modernized disciplines from this program are:

- Entrepreneurship and leadership 5 ECTS credits;
- · Econometrics and economic statistics 5 ECTS credits;
- · Strategic analysis and competitive business strategies 5 ECTS credits;
- · Innovative development of enterprises 5 ECTS credits;
- Quality management systems 5 ECTS credits;
- Financial-accounting management 5 ECTS credits.




This contest is an opportunity to promote the business ideas of master students, and why not, of successful future entrepreneurs.

The Department of Economic Sciences, Faculty of Economics, Engineering and Applied Sciences, hosted online teaching activities for teachers from European partner universities within the ReSTART project between March 4-12 and April 10, 2021,



The objective of these activities is the exchange of experience and good practices in the field of entrepreneurial education.

The teaching activities were supported by expert professors from the Polytechnic University of Bucharest (Romania) - Prof. Dr. Eng. Gheorghe MILITARU and Prof. Dr. Eng. Elena FLEACĂ, from the University Agency of Francophonie in Bucharest (Romania) - Mrs. Natalia DOHOTARU-ROBU.

The areas discussed cover the topics in the discipline of Financial-Accounting Management and Strategic Analysis and Competitive Business Strategies, in the master's program in Entrepreneurship and Business Administration.

These courses registered high appreciations by the master students in the chapter: the topicality of the discussed subjects and the way of interaction with the students; communication and collaboration between the actors of the educational act, group work, etc.





CAREER ORIENTATION ACTIVITIES

The 6th Career Orientation Session, within the RESTART project (no. 585353-EPP-1-2017-1-RO-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP, Reinforce entrepreneurial and digital skills of students and teachers to enhance the modernization of higher education in MOLDOVA) took place online on 11-14 May 2021.



This event was hosted by the Department of Economic Sciences of the Faculty of Economics, Engineering and Applied Sciences. This time the format of this event was different.

On the first day, May 11, 2021, the first part of the event took place, during which we had as guest of honor a local entrepreneur from Cahul, Mr. Susanu Boris, general manager and founder of the I.I. Liusi Susanu, Construct Univers SRL, Gebhardt Construct SRL, Eurotrans Sud SRL, Industrial Invest SRL, the majority shareholder (about 90%) of SA PAT + 8, in a word the founder of the Gebhardt group of companies. The topic of discussion was the Entrepreneurial Skills needed to create and develop a business. During the event, Mr. Susanu Boris shared his own experience regarding the stages taken in the development of a successful business of his own, in the conditions of permanent crisis, which was characteristic of the Republic of Moldova. He also drew attention to the factors that lead to the success of the entrepreneur, as well as mentioned the importance of self-cultivation and self-development of entrepreneurial skills.

On the 2nd day, 14.05.2021, the second part of the event took place, where we had as guests the European experts, the project partners: Dr. Beatrice Leuştean from the Polytechnic University of Bucharest; Dr. Bozhana STOYCHEVA from the University of Ruse Angel Kanchev, Bulgaria; Dr. Radova Drab from the Technical University of Kosice, Slovakia; and Ms. Dohotaru-Robu from the University Agency of Francophonie in Bucharest, shared their own experience in the institutions they represent regarding the organization of students' career guidance. The University of La Francophonie Agency in Bucharest had a unique experience that brought to the attention of students and master students which they can use in their professional growth.
